

# Frankenstein Vocab Assignment

## Add an entry to your journal ...

Please add “Frankenstein Vocab” to your journal’s Table of Contents (right after “Jane Eyre Vocab”), and title the next available page with that same name.

## Find a few good words ...

Take your time with this. The assignment is designed so that you’ll add vocabulary gradually throughout your reading of the novel. I’m asking you to select 11 words from Frankenstein. I prefer if you space those selections out; it’s not coincidence that there are 11 chunks on your reading calendar for the novel. Please thoughtfully select words that meet the following criteria:

1. The word is presently unfamiliar to you.
2. The word (once looked up) seems useful to know more intimately.
3. The word is not archaic, obscure, or otherwise sort of useless.

## For each word ...

- Write, number (#1-11), and underline the word.
- Provide the chapter number that it was found in.
- Write its part of speech.
- Write a practical definition that is sensible to you.
- Then choose to do one of the following:
  - Record the clause in which it appears in the novel.
  - Use it in an effective sentence of your own creation.
  - Provide a clever, effective means of recalling the word’s meaning.
