

Theme Writing #2

Add “Theme Writing #2” to your Table of Contents. **Don’t begin this assignment until we’ve completed the *Great Expectations* notes and you’ve signed up to track one of the novel’s themes in class.** Please refer to the Proofreading Expectations before continuing, and read the directions carefully.

#1 – Theme Connection (minimum of 4 sentences for each part)

- a. (1st paragraph) Briefly, creatively explain why you chose the theme you did for *Great Expectations*. How does your chosen theme relate to your own life and experiences?
- b. (2nd paragraph) Provide an anecdote (a short story from your own life) that illustrates this theme’s role in your own life and experiences.

#2 – Choose One (Either A or B)

- A. Create a full-page well-designed color illustration that communicates the meaning and importance of your chosen theme in your own life.
- B. Copy down the lyrics (or a portion of the lyrics) to a song that pertains to your chosen theme’s role in your own life or experience. Then, in three or four sentences, explain your choice of the song and its meaning to you.
