Watchmen Response Journal

- Be sure to complete your journal responses as you read the text. Incorporate journaling into your reading process; all the cool kids are doin' it.
- Here's the due date schedule for responses to be submitted to Turnitin.com:
 - O Nov. 11th: 4 responses are due from chapters I-III
 - O Nov. 20th: 4 responses are due from chapters IV-VII
 - O Dec. 2nd: 4 responses are due from chapters VIII-X
 - O Dec. 9th: 4 responses are due from chapters XI-XII
- Citation format is: (chapter.page.panel). So chapter II, page 3, panel 4 would be (II.3.4). And chapter IX, page 12, panels 1-8 would be (IX.12.1-8).
- Because of the visual format of <u>Watchmen</u>, you may choose to respond to either
 a specific quote, a single panel, or a series of panels. If you use a quote, type
 it out. If you select a panel or a series of panels, briefly summarize the
 contents; the summary should be brief (I-2 sentences) but accurate.
- * In the critical portion of each response, strive to genuinely analyze (A-TEAM) a specific portion of the text in a focused way with mechanical precision. Refer to the notes to help you in analyzing stylistic motifs and thematic elements.
- ** In the **personal** portion of each response, be **genuine** with your thoughts and **expressive** in your style as you connect with the text. Refer to your textbook (specifically pg. 10-11) for help with effective interactions with literature.
 - Select **one** response from each due date as your **favorite** from that set, and submit it in **bold-face** type. You may be asked to bring in a hardcopy of some of your best journal entries for class discussion.
 - Be sure that each of your responses includes all of the following:
 - o the quote or a short summary of the panel(s) you've chosen
 - o properly-formatted citation (see above, beneath the due dates)
 - * your personal response consider "talking with the text"- see p. 33-34 of as well as your own life (p. 156-157) textbook

 * your critical response refer to notes on postmodernism and Watchmen,
 p. 19-24 of textbook (for tips on close reading).
