

# Peermark Instructions

## for Literary Analysis Task #2

One of our learning **goals** in class for this year is that all students use **technology**, including the Internet, to produce, publish, and update individual or **shared** writing products in response to ongoing **feedback**, including new arguments or information (LAFS.910.W.2.6). **Turnitin.com** is one resource we can use to get some practice with this important **21<sup>st</sup>-century** skill. The goal of this specific assignment (Peermarking) is that you carefully **read** one of your peers' essays before completing a thoughtful, critical **review** of its content, structure, and style.

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To complete the Peermark assignment, follow the steps below:

1. Log in to **Turnitin.com**.
2. Click on **this class' name**.
3. Underneath "Literary Analysis Task #2" and to the far-right of "Peermark" beneath it, you will see a gray button labeled "**Start Review**"; click it.
4. After carefully reading your peer's (classmate's) essay, **complete the review questions** on the right with thoughtful, critical responses; when you complete the review, click the yellowish "**Submit**" button in the top-right corner.
