1) Create an organized chart detailing exactly what both Gawain and the lord of the castle earn and what they give each other on each of the three days of Part Three (discussed in class while reading).

2) Write a 25 word précis that summarizes Part Three.

Follow the exact same specific directions given in the previous journal handout for Parts One and Two.

3) Create a full-page, labeled, sequential illustration (a series of pictures that illustrates an order of events, like a comic book) of Gawain's encounter with the Green Knight in Part Four. Cite at least five specific details from the text in your drawing (with line numbers).

4) Write a 25 word précis that summarizes Part Four.

5) What do Parts Three and Four have to do with each other? Explain how Parts Four and Three relate to each other and why they're important to the poem's story as a whole.

6) Explain Gawain's journey as a literary quest (as covered in the notes). Is Gawain successful in his quest? What "self knowledge" does he gain by the end of the story? Include at least one cited, woven quotation as a part of your response.
