How to Create a Khan Academy Account and Link to the PSAT scores

Step 1: Log on to [Satpractice.org](https://satpractice.org) using Firefox or Chrome. You will see a blue and white screen that says "Official SAT Practice" and in the middle of the page is a button that says "Check it out now". When you click that button, you will go to a screen and have to determine how to sign in.

Step 2: If you choose to sign up with email, you will have to be able to access that email immediately, because Khan sends a link to the subscriber via email that has to be clicked to open the account. Please use your Portal email at <https://portal.office.com/Home> (your username and password are the same as your R2D2 number that you use to log on.)

Step 3: After creating a Khan account, when you sign in to SATpractice.org you will see a button that says "Practice Now."
