

PREP #10

- Add at least five credible sources to your Annotated Bibliography; vouch for their credibility using CRAAP analysis. (Your goal is to determine what the experts/scholars have already written about the topics important to your research question; use scholarly/peer-reviewed articles from EBSCO/Gale or relevant primary sources as your go-to.)
- Complete your Annotated Bibliography with a minimum of 15 sources with a minimum of 250 words each; use the directions for PREP #4 (goo.gl/kqB822) if you need more guidance in terms of what to write about each source.
- Format your Annotated Bibliography to match the formatting (e.g. APA, Chicago, AMA, MLA) of the majority of your sources; use Purdue OWL to ensure that you're complying with all standards. (If you're off-format, you'll lose significant credit.)
- Upload your final Annotated Bibliography as PREP #10 to Turnitin.com.
