#5a On a single page, discuss how George Orwell makes use of **literary devices** (e.g. foreshadowing, irony, imagery, motifs, symbols) in 1984 to develop the thematic motif you are tracking on your Theme Log; include relevant examples in the form of woven, cited quotations in your response. (Please refer to the Weaving & Citation Guide on bentonenglish.com.)

#5b On a single page, prepare an outline (including your thesis, topic sentences/supporting points, and cited quotation support) for the following prompt:

From **either** Things Fall Apart or one of the short stories we read earlier this semester, analyze how the author uses a **minor character** to develop a thematic motif in the story. (Refer to the list below for your block's assigned thematic concept.)

- A3-4: fear
- B3-4: parent/child relationships **or** gender
- C3-4: justice
