<u>REQUIRED ELEMENT</u>	<u>DESCRIPTION</u>
<b>Introduction</b>	<p>Provides background and contextualizes the research question/project goal and initial student assumptions and/or hypotheses.</p> <p>Introduces and reviews previous work in the field, synthesizing information and a range of perspectives related to the research question/project goal.</p> <p>Identifies the gap in the current field of knowledge to be addressed.</p>
<b>Method, Process, or Approach</b>	<p>Explains and provides justification for the chosen method, process, or approach.</p>
<b>Results, Product, or Findings</b>	<p>Presents the findings, evidence, results, or product.</p>
<b>Discussion, Analysis, and/or Evaluation</b>	<p>Interprets the significance of the results, product, or findings; explores connections to original research question/project goal.</p> <p>Discusses the implications and limitations of the research or creative work.</p>
<b>Conclusion and Future Directions</b>	<p>Reflects on the process and how this project could impact the field.</p> <p>Discusses possible next steps.</p>
<b>Bibliography</b>	<p>Provides a complete list of sources cited and consulted in the appropriate disciplinary style.</p>
