

## **THEY ALL SAW A FRESHMAN**

We all interact with – and are perceived by – different groups of people.

- 1) Identify three people with whom you interact regularly.  
The three people should come from three different groups (e.g. teachers, friends, teammates, parents, siblings, grandparents, coaches).
- 2) Consider how perception is portrayed in *They All Saw a Cat*. Try to put yourself into the shoes of the three people you chose. How do they see you? How can you visually represent that?
- 3) You need to end up with three illustrations of yourself. Each should be labeled “The \_\_\_\_\_ saw a freshman,” with the blank filled in with that person’s relationship to you.
- 4) Each illustration should be half of an 8.5 x 11” piece of paper (8.5 x 5.5”). Your illustration can be created using whatever style or method suits you. I will provide some materials; feel free to bring your own.
- 5) We will share our illustrations with the class, but you will not have to present them.
