- 3a.** Provide an example of a sentence from Part 1 that creates tension in the plot.
- Copy down the sentence from capital letter to period; enclose it inside quotation marks and cite it. After the quotation, explain how the sentence creates tension.)
- 3b.** Select a passage from Part 2 in which the poet's decision to use a slow pace in telling the story affects the meaning of the text.
- Summarize the passage in one sentence. In another, explain how the slow place affects the meaning of the text.
- 3c.** Select a passage from Part 3 in which the author creates a complex tone (more than one attitude at the same time).
- Summarize the passage in one sentence. In another, identify the tone. In a third sentence, explain how the author creates that tone.
