

# AP Research Midterm Responsibilities

## 1) the Paper (a third of your exam grade)

### CONTENT

- the most current version of your Lit Review section
- the most current version of your Methods section
- a References/Bibliography section that includes all sources

### DETAILS

- fully consistent academic format (e.g. APA, Chicago, AMA)
- file titled "Academic Paper" & saved it to your shared PREP folder
- Word Count included for the combined Lit Review & Methods sections
- file uploaded to Turnitin by start of scheduled exam block\*

## 2) the PREP (a third of your exam grade)

### CONTENT

- include all previously submitted PREPs from #1 to #18\*\*
- include final IRB / IPF / Cover Letter & approval email from Mrs. Vigue

### ORGANIZATION

- all entries dated and organized in chronological order
- neat Table of Contents (including page numbers & all included entries)
- file uploaded to Turnitin by start of scheduled exam block\*

## 3) the Presentation (a third of your exam grade)

### CONTENT

- at least two relevant PowerPoint slides
- some specific reference to secondary sources (e.g. scholarly work)
- the research question / project goal
- explanation of the research method(s)
- the steps you've taken in the research process so far
- preview of the work you've yet to complete (e.g. primary research)

### DELIVERY

- presented on your scheduled day (teal clipboard on top of laptop cart)
- at least three, no more than four minutes
- emphatic gestures & movement
- eye contact & vocal variety
