- Select and use evidence — either direct quotation, paraphrase, or summary — from at least three of the provided sources (including at least one your partner annotated) to support your line of reasoning. Each reason must be supported by evidence from two or more sources. (In other words, you can't have a reason supported only with evidence from a single source.)
- Indicate clearly the sources you used through by citing them as A, B, C, D, E, F, G, or H.
- Provide commentary that explains how the evidence supports your thesis.
