

# Graduation Requirements

Class of 2016

To earn a standard high school diploma, students entering 9<sup>th</sup> grade in 2012 must meet the following requirements.

1. Earn 24 credits including the subject area requirements listed below.
2. Receive a passing score on the Grade 10 FCAT 2.0 Reading test.
3. Have a cumulative unweighted grade point average of 2.0.
4. Complete at least one course within the 24 credits required through online learning.

## *Subject Area Requirements*

<b>English:</b>	4 credits
<b>Mathematics:</b>	4 credits: Includes one credit of Algebra I or its equivalent (EOC required), one credit of Geometry (EOC required), and one credit of Algebra II.
<b>Science:</b>	3 credits: Includes one credit in Biology I (EOC required)
<b>Social Studies:</b>	3 credits: American Government (½) World History (1) American History (1) Economics (½)
<b>PE/Health:</b>	1 Credit: HOPE
<b>Fine Art:</b>	1 credit: Art, Music, Drama, Journalism, or Speech Some practical arts courses may apply (check with your counselor)
<b>Electives:</b>	8 credits

**Note: Students entering a state-supported university must have at least two credits in a sequential foreign language as well as a minimum of four math credits in Algebra I and above.**
